He has directed *Here Lies Love*, the Fatboy Slim musical, at the National Theatre in London and *Putting It Together*, a Sondheim review, at the St. James Theatre. His works for musical theatre have been performed at King's Place, Shaw Theatre, and Blackheath concert halls. His orchestrations for Adam Guettel and Maria Friedman have also been performed in concert.
